

**STATEMENT OF ORGANIZATION AND PURPOSE**

The Governmental Affairs committee is a bylaws appointed committee under Article XIII. The Committee Chairperson shall appoint such Task Forces as may from time to time be required, including, but not limited to, Issues & Review, RPAC, Political Affairs and Call-To-Action. The Chairperson, Vice-Chairperson and members shall be appointed by the Association President with the approval of the Board of Directors.

The Committee shall meet in regularly scheduled monthly sessions at the hour and date determined by the Chairperson. It may be called into special session at the direction of the Chairperson or the Association President.

The Chairperson or Vice-Chairperson shall attend all regular meetings of the Board of Directors and will have the privileges of the floor when reporting for the Committee.

Committee primary purposes are:

1. To encourage member participation in the many levels of government affecting the real estate industry.
2. To be aware of legislation and laws that may effect the ownership of real estate and/or other areas of real estate practice, be it local, state or national in scope.
3. To encourage support of candidates and issues, to interview candidates, assist with candidate forums, and to provide input to candidate platforms.
4. To encourage the active participation of all members of the Association in RPAC.
5. To influence the Nebraska Real Estate Commission on issues pertaining to our business.
6. To perform such other related tasks as may from time to time be assigned by the Association President.
